


Starting and Operating a Business in Massachusetts (Starting and Operating a Business in the U.S. Book 2015)

FEDERAL LAWS AND TAXES Federal tax and legal coverage includes individual income, self-employment, estate, gift, and excise taxes, federal payroll taxes, withholding of various taxes; securities laws and regulations; the Americans with Disabilities Act; environmental laws; minimum wage/overtime and child labor laws; anti-discrimination and Healthcare Reform laws that apply to employers; immigration laws affecting hiring; OSHA job safety and health requirements; ERISA (employee benefits) compliance; the Family and Medical Leave Act rules; mail order sales and telemarketing regulations; Internet taxes and regulation; and much more.

MASSACHUSETTS LAWS AND TAXES Massachusetts tax and legal coverage includes the Massachusetts state income tax, state corporate income and/or franchise taxes, Massachusetts sales and

use, property, and unemployment taxes, withholding of employment taxes and other state and local business taxes; state fair employment laws, which differ from federal; the Massachusetts minimum wage, overtime, and child labor laws; the new (2015) PAID sick leave requirement; mandatory workers compensation insurance and new hires reporting; wage payment requirements; when/if registration of fictitious business names (trade names) is required; and much more. **OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND ADVICE** In addition to extensive, up-to-date coverage of federal and Massachusetts business laws and taxes, you will also find this e-book to be a gold mine of other useful information and advice for running your business.
