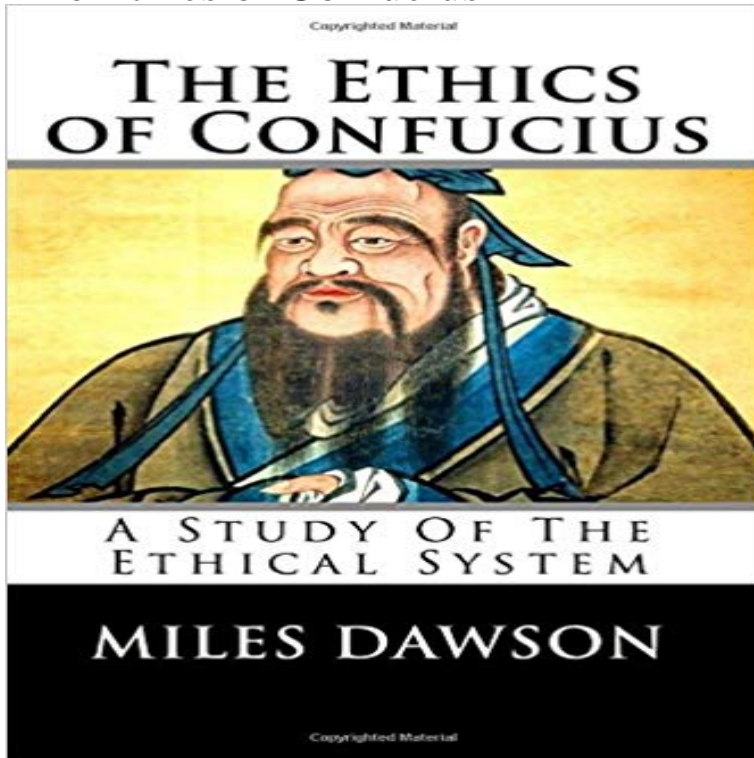


# The Ethics of Confucius
