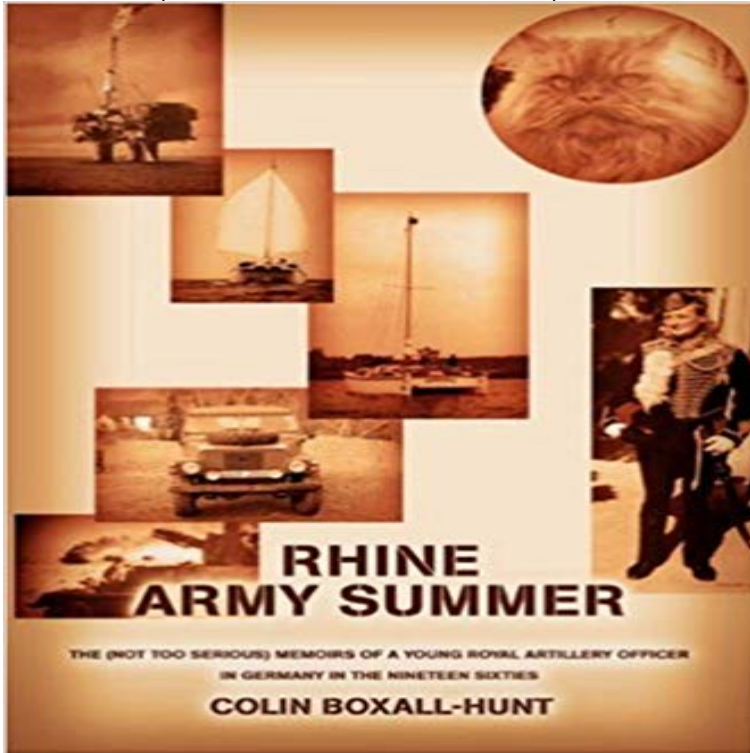


# Rhine Army Summer: The (not too serious) memoirs of a young Royal Artillery Officer in Germany in the Nineteen Sixties
